events, after all that tragedy. We were all happy to enjoy the wedding of Brian and Angie (just now announcing their second new baby) and other weddings and anniversaries. My high school class's 50th anniversary (55 and counting) was a big event for us. We had a lot of fun discussing memories of our high school days.

Also among the most fun and big events are births. The birth of children enriches our lives, of course, but for most of us in this congregation nowadays it tends to be the births of grandchildren.

We can also think of other big events. For Ginnie and me, most of them have to do with children and grandchildren. We look forward to any opportunity to be with them. Two weeks ago we drove to Arkadelphia (now in Russellville) Yesterday morning, we got up earlier than we wanted to on a Saturday to see Moira play basketball (Abigail - volleyball).

When Gail and Emory were in school, we tried to be at every game where they were cheering or twirling a baton. At one point, we worked the band booths for food stand at peevee, junior high and high school football games. Gail was a peevee cheerleader and Emory was a junior high cheerleader and in the senior high school. We attended all of Emory's study and musical events at both schools, for several performances, and we

recently attended the Nutcracker performance, which included both Gail and Moira.

So big events can involve anything our children or grandchildren are doing.

Are you wondering where I am headed with this?

This is a sermon, so I need to relate it to religion.

So let's begin with the Old Testament. What were the big events? The creation of the earth is a good place to start. There was also the big flood, in which Noah saved a pair of all the creatures of the earth. Then there was the parting of the Red Sea to help Moses lead the Israelites out of Egypt, the handing down of the 10 commandments, and the tower of Babel, whose collapse resulted in the spreading of different languages.

Since we are Christians, we are more concerned with the big events of the New Testament.

There are the miracles of Jesus, including the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, truly a big event involving a lot of people. Jesus' appearance in the temple at age 12 and impressing the priests with his knowledge was one. Another was Jesus' overturning the tables and chasing the money changers out of the temple.

But you may be wanting me to note the three biggest, which were the birth of Jesus, his crucifixion, and his resurrection.

The important thing, of course, is that God did send his son into the world, "so that whosoever believeth in him shall not perish but have everlasting life."

Perhaps it is enough just to agree that this is the biggest event in the history of the world, just that Jesus came and lived a life like the rest of us.

We in journalism measure big events - news, in other words, by at list of news values - timeliness, proximity, prominence, consequence, human interest, novelty and conflict.

The life of Jesus provides us with plenty of all of those elements. But most importantly, it provides us with consequence. Without him, we are left with despair and lack of direction. With him, we have hope and promise. He showed us how to live by living himself.

As Grantland Rice famously said, "It's not whether you win or lose, but how you play the game." It's not the big events that matter, but how we live our lives day to day - making mistakes but keeping on trying to follow Jesus' example. Living our human lives one small event at a time.

And that is certainly much more important than a football game. But that doesn't mean we can't enjoy the football game and the commercials and halftime show.
