

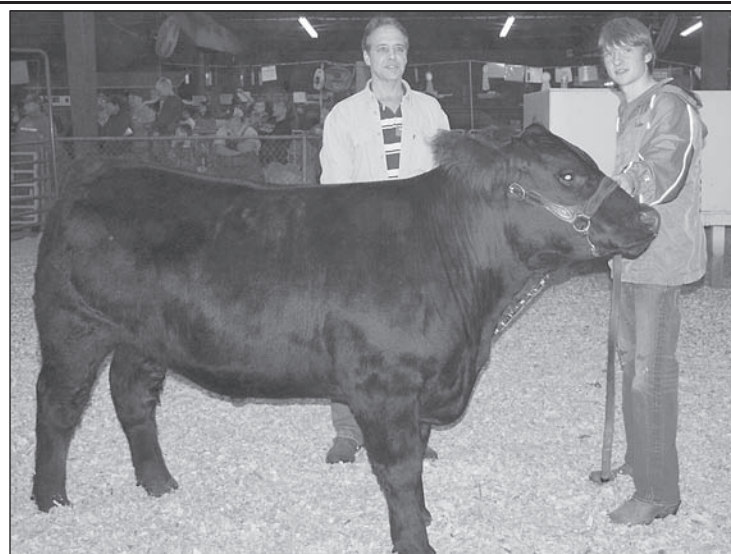

Grand Champion Market Steer shown by Colton Jones is shown with Jay Price. Price Milling bought the steer for \$1,000.



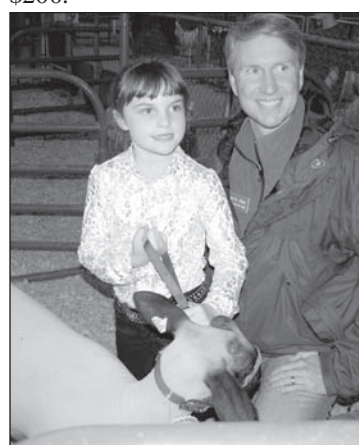
Reserve Champion Market Lamb shown by Sarah-Beth Bates with Robert and Glenda Bridges. The Bridges family bought the goat for \$450.



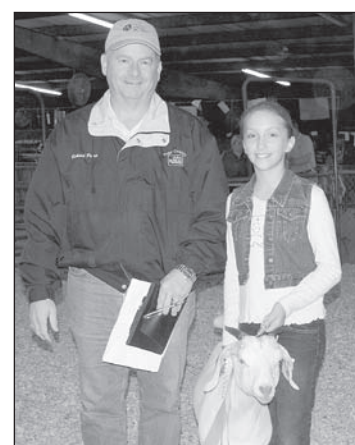

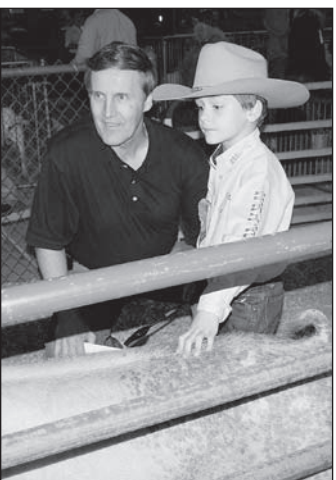
Grand Champion Rainbow shown by McKenzie Hood is shown with Lance Martin of Tyson Foods. Tyson bought the chickens for \$200.

Reserve Champion Meat Goat shown by Katelyn Danzy is shown with Lance Martin of Tyson Foods. Tyson bought the goat for \$350.



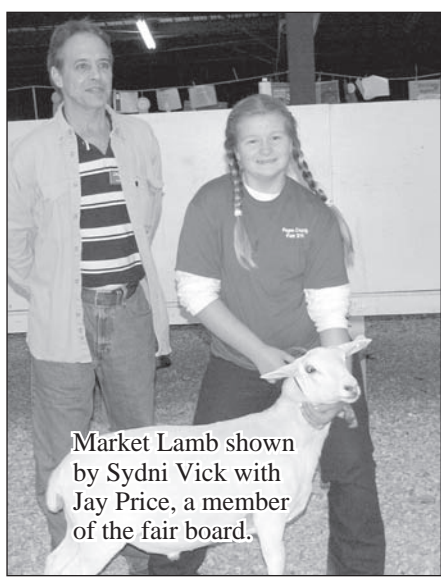
Grand Champion Single Fryer shown by Dayna Walker is shown with Horace Beavers. Beavers Air Conditioning bought the rabbit for \$175.

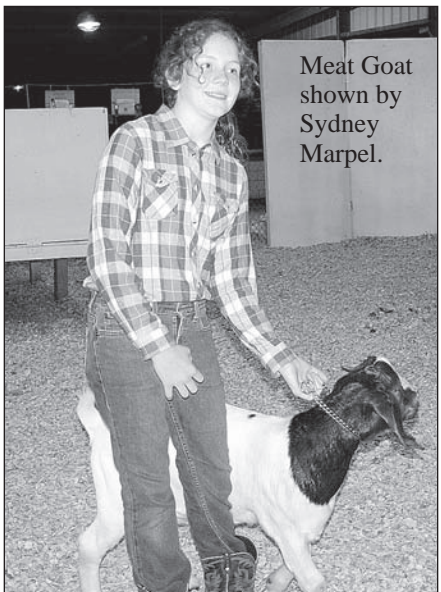

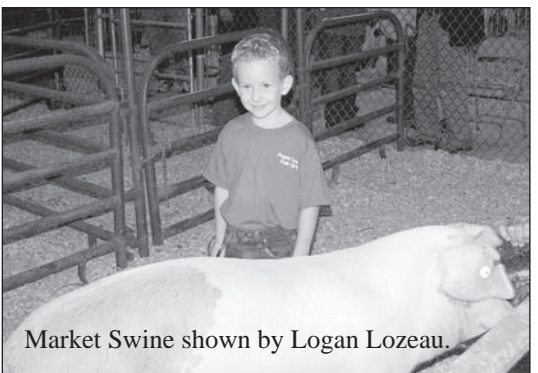

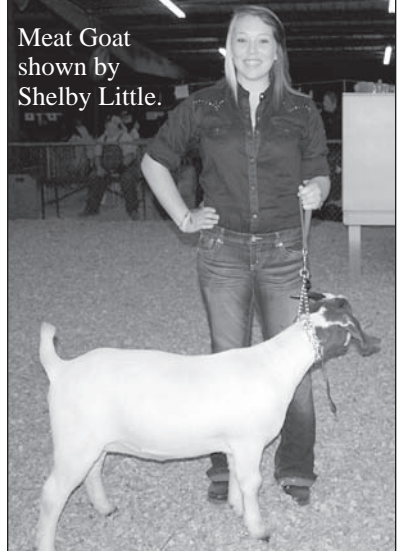
